ESSENTIALS OF COUNCIL DOC C6-07.4A

- The revised Statutes of the HCA entered into force in May 2022
- As a follow up, HCA agreed that Article 8.e of the General Regulations of the IHO needed to be reconsidered.
- HCA18 endorsed proposed amendments to Art. 8.e and tasked the HCA Secretariat to submit these proposed amendments for Council's endorsement, then submit it to A-3 as Council proposal for final approval.

Art. 8 (e): "Full membership is reserved for Member States within the region.
In the unique case of the Antarctic region, membership of the Hydrographic
Commission on Antarctica (HCA) is reserved for Member States whose
governments have acceded to the Antarctic Treaty and contribute resources
and/or data to IHO INT Chart coverage of Region M."

Proposed version

Art. 8 (e): "Full membership is reserved for Member States within the region.
In the unique case of the Antarctic region, membership of the Hydrographic
Commission on Antarctica (HCA) is reserved for Member States whose
governments have acceded to the Antarctic Treaty and contribute resources to
the provision of hydrographic data, products and services supporting marine
safety of navigation within, and/or the wider marine geospatial information of
the Antarctic region."
