


Mediterranean and Black Sea Hydrographic Commission (MBSHC)

- To coordinate hydrographic activities and cooperation in the area
- The Regional Hydrographic Commissions (RHCs) are made up of IHO Member States together with other regional States that wish to participate
- RHCs work in close harmony with the Organization to help further its ideals and program

Hydrographic Services and Standards Committee (HSSC)

• To promote and coordinate the development of standards, specifications and guidelines for official products and services to meet the requirements of mariners and other users of hydrographic information





Hydrographic surveys support:


- geospatial data collection across the land-sea interface

- off-shore activities


HYDROGRAPHY IS THE FOUNDATION UPON WHICH ANY TYPE OF MARINE ACTIVITY IS DEVOLEPED













HOs for EU Maritime Spatial Planning



- DIRECTIVE 2014/89/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 July 2014 establishes a framework for Maritime Spatial Planning (MSP)
- Possible activities/uses include:
 - Fisheries and aquaculture
 - Energy infrastructure
 - Maritime transport routes
 - Marine Spatial Planning
 - Marine Strategy
 - Scientific research
 - Submarine cables and pipelines
 - Tourism and underwater cultural heritage
 - Data Standards

Standardized, certified and consistent hydrographic and cartographic data












A stronger HO-EU cooperation for better European governance




- Hydrography and Cartography are paramount for EU sea-coastal strategies

- IHO must have a leading connection role towards EU Commission through IENWG


