- Highest attendance with over 60 delegates
- Active Working Groups including the appointment of an S100 Coordinator



SAIHC19 Delegates in Mauritius

 Delivered a successful Hydrographic Awareness Seminar (HAS) on Alternative Survey Methods



Important Findings (RHC top 3 challenges)

- Varying level of technical maturity within the digital and S-100 space
- There is a lack of data coverage to meet the Seabed 2030 goals
- Identifying and securing wider funding for increased data collection



Lessons Learned

- Importance of collaborative resources such as industry and IHO capacity building funds to improve regional skills, knowledge and experience
- Understanding of our rich and diverse community with differing challenges and priorities
